

CITY COMMISSION WORK SESSION MINUTES

November 28, 2017

The Newton City Commission met for a work session on November 28, 2017. Present were Mayor Hague, Commissioners Davis, Koehn and Valentine and City staff. Vice Mayor Nygaard was absent.

Mayor Hague called the work session to order at 5:00 p.m. The City Commission heard a proposal from representatives of Occidental Management for a possible commercial development on South Kansas Avenue. Following the presentation, the Commission held several executive sessions.

MOTION: Commissioner Valentine moved and Commission Davis seconded to go into executive session to executive session to discuss proprietary information concerning an economic development prospect, with the justification being to discuss data relating to financial affairs or trade secrets of corporations, partnerships, trust or individual proprietorships, and to return to open session at 6:25 p.m. in the 3rd floor conference room. Motion carried.

The Commission went back into executive session at 6:10 p.m. and reconvened at 6:25 p.m.



Motion carried.
