

JOINT CITY-COUNTY SPECIAL CITY MEETING MINUTES
June 5, 2019

The Newton City Commission convened in a special meeting with the Harvey County Commission on June 5, 2019 at 12:00 p.m. in the 3rd Floor Conference Room, 201 East 6th Street. Attending for the City of Newton were Mayor Valentine, Vice Mayor Koehn, Commissioners Davis, Hague and Kreie, and City staff.

Those in attendance from Harvey County included Commissioners Krehbiel, Hague and Westfall, and County staff.

1. Discuss Funding of the Newton City-County Airport Building Maintenance and Master Capital Improvement Plan.


In order to make sure the building maintenance and the capital improvement plan for the Airport are funded properly, City staff has been going over all the deferred maintenance lists. Currently, each entity is contributing \$80,000 into the Airport operating fund, plus sharing debt service for bonds. It is time to consider increasing this funding for ongoing capital needs. Staff suggested looking at bonding the bigger ticket items, like the hangar door replacements, new roofs, parking lot paving, etc.

Staff presented the five-year forecast for the Airport. It was suggested that each entity look at putting \$10,000 more into the operating budget. A decision on the additional funds will need to be made by July.

2. General Discussion as to Issues of Common Interest to the City and County Governments.

An update was given on the leases with AVCON as well as possible expansion of Hesston College's facilities at the Airport. Also noted was Park Aerospace is finalizing the design for their expansion and have expressed an interest in using Industrial Revenue Bonds.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:53 p.m.
