New playgrounds open at Centennial Park

Two new playgrounds are now open to the public at Centennial Park.

The two new play structures are located on each side of the open shelter at Centennial. They are designed in a tree house theme with leaf roofs and are surrounded by a sand fall zone. The structures replace the former play system, which had been in place since 1977.

The small play area is designed for children ages 2 to 12, and features a typhoon slide, climbing wall, bump-and-glide slide, and a set of tot swings.

The larger structure is for children ages 5 to 12. Features include a tube slide, wiggly worm climber, twisted vine climber, hollow log climber, chameleon slide, and a fossil bluff climber. An above-deck fun phone system allows children to talk to each other located at two different points on the structure. Also in the large structure area is a set of four swings, a flippo offspring rider, and an individual climbing component that features a round up climber, hang around, and a hover beam.
