Each sealed envelope containing a BID must be plainly marked on the outside as BID for <u>Building Demolition at 320 N. Main,</u> <u>Newton, KS.</u> and the envelope should bear on the outside the name of the BIDDER, his address, his license number if applicable and the name of the project for which the BID is submitted.
